Conditions of Entry

This Competition shall be conducted under the rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ except for Events No's 5, 6 & 15 which are open to both P&D and unregistered non-P&D pipers. Every P&D competitor shall produce a membership certificate for the current year when asked to do so and if unable to do so may be required to apply for membership forthwith – if they wish to compete in P&D sanctioned events.

ENTRIES MUST BE FORWARDED BY THE 28TH NOVEMBER 2009

PLEASE NOTE - LATE ENTRIES will incur a penalty of double the entry fees

(We reserve the right to withhold certain prize monies if entries are lower than 5 competitors in each event)

- P & D Rules relating to Pipers Dress will be adhered to. In the event of a tie for a trophy Rule 13 of the P & D Rules will apply.
- Rule 37 regarding tuning will be enforced. Competitors risk disqualification if they are not ready to play when called upon.
- No New Zealand, North Island or Centre Championship shall be awarded unless there are not fewer than 5 competitors in the event and the Judge certifies the winning performance is of standard to merit the award of the Championship. This rule also applies to Drumming Events.

Competitors MUST report to Board Stewards at least 5 minutes prior to each event, otherwise their right to compete may be forfeited.

Tuning time at the board will be at the judge's discretion.

All events: 3 entries - 1st Prize only awarded 5 entries - 1st & 2nd Prizes awarded 7 entries - 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prizes awarded 15 or more entries - A 4th Prize will be awarded

NOTE: Any competitor who is a previous winner of D Grade events is advised to enter other grades.

All Drumming Competitors are required to provide their own accompanying Pipers and to be suitably attired. Competitors are asked to wear Highland Dress when being presented with a trophy either in Piping or Drumming Prize giving.

GENERAL PIPING AND DRUMMING NOTES

- All Premium & Open Grade events require three tunes of each time signature to be submitted to the Piping Steward on the day of competition.
- B Grade Championship competitors must submit 2 x tunes each event. Judges nominate which tune to play.
- Under 21 events require two tunes in each event to be submitted to Chief Steward prior to event.
- Novice Event is for competitors who have not won a Novice competition before and have not competed at a National Contest
- Novice Pipers are listed as D Grade for these competitions.
- Pipers may enter in their own grade and one above.
- Event 5 Music: Own choice of any tunes lasting no less than 6 minutes and no more than 8 minutes.
- Event 6. Music: Own choice. Minimum playing time of 3 minutes - maximum 5 minutes.
- Event 8 & 8A B Grade & U21 Piobaireachd will be combined, but judged separately. Notify Judge & Steward prior to playing.
- U21 competitors can pay & enter both events. Prizes will be awarded in both categories
- Under 21 pipers note. A 4th placing will be awarded in all your events, although prize money may not be paid (depending on entries)
- A \$2 refundable charge will be made for competitor's numbers.
- Winning Pipers or Drummers MUST wear correct Highland dress for Trophy presentation

DRUMMING NOTES

- Novice - A drummer, who has been learning for no longer than 2 years, has not won a Novice competition before and has not competed as a band drummer at a NZ National Contest.
- Intermediate Drummer = previously competed with band or solo.
- Open Drummer = Competed at National level or minimum centre competition level.
- Bass & Tenor Section Open. Ensemble & Flourishing

The 2010 William Boyle Memorial piping events will be held in conjunction with the Waipu Caledonian Scholarship for competitors under 21years

The U21 Piobaireachd event will be held in conjunction with the B Grade Piobaireachd. **Prize Money will be awarded in both classes and U21 Competitors can pay & compete for both events in this competition.** The second event for WBM scholarship competitors will be the U21 Strathspey & Reel. **The first four place-getters in these TWO events will qualify for WBM Scholarship placing. The third Under21 Event will be the 2/4 March and this event will be the final qualifying event for the Caledonian Scholarship.**

Compete in **ALL** three events and have points awarded as follows.
Points System: 10 (1st) - 6 (2nd) - 4 (3rd) - 2 (4th).

The piper securing most points will win the Caledonian scholarship 1st Prize of \$300 and the Runner Up will receive \$200 (Only 2x prizes will be awarded)
