<u>Programmes available</u> on application with entries, cost to be met by competitors.

All trophies remain the property of Otago Centre. Trophies are held by the winners for one year only, or such time as the Centre may prescribe and must be returned whenever requested in good condition. Competitors will be held liable for the cost of any repairs required.

2017 Trophy Holders: Please note that all trophies must be in the Secretary's hands by Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2018. If posting, please pack trophies adequately.

#### PIPING CONDITIONS

- 1. All events will be conducted under the rules of the Piping and Dancing Association of N.Z. (Inc.)
- 2. All competitors compete at their own risk.
- 3. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by all fees. This will be strictly adhered to.
- 4. All competitors must be registered for the year 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018. Registration fee \$30 for under 18 years, \$50 for 18 years and over. Current registration cards must be produced when uplifting competitors number.
- 5. All competitors must produce birth certificate when called upon to do so.
- 6. Any competitor entering in the wrong class is liable to disqualification throughout New Zealand.
- 7. Prizes in events (except championships where a minimum of five competitors are required)
  3 entries: 1 prize 5 entries: 2 prizes 7 entries: 3 prizes 15 entries: 4 prizes
  In piping events with 25 or more entries, an additional 5<sup>th</sup> prize will be awarded.
- 8. No New Zealand or South Island championship will be awarded unless the judge certifies the winning performance is of sufficient standard to merit the award.
- 9. In the event of a tie for a trophy, Rule 13 will apply aggregate points will be used.
- 10. Any person found damaging venue property will be liable for full restitution and, if a competitor, may forfeit the right to compete.
- 11. Local competitors must reside within 30km radius of the octagon.
- 12. At the discretion of the Otago Centre Executive, late entries may be accepted from bona fide overseas competitors.
- 13. Competitors in the PIPING SECTION please note:
  - Piping Judges shall award points to all competitors in all events.
  - Competitors in B Grade competitions and above shall tune their own pipes whilst on the competition platform without any
    outside assistance for tuning.
  - PIPERS DRESS: By-laws will be adhered to
  - Pipers may enter in their own grade and one grade above in Light Music events; any <u>one</u> Piobaireachd event in their own grade or above; together with age-group events as appropriate.
  - Entry to the Dunedin Silver Medal event is restricted to <u>all</u> pipers who are B Grade or lower.
  - In all Piobaireachd events, pipers shall make available to the judge a legible copy of the music to be played.
  - Tunes played in Light Music events in all grades shall be a minimum of 4 parts.
  - Tunes for Open, A, B, and U21 grades and special events shall be submitted prior; selection will be advised to pipers either on entering the Final Tuning Room, or on entering the Hall. Please refer to the Pipers Tune Submission form.
  - B Grade and Under 21 Events The judge shall nominate the tune/tunes to be played. Two tunes of each time signature to be submitted EXCEPT that three tunes are to be submitted for the Dunedin Silver Medal Piobaireachd.
  - Under 21 Events qualify for the William Boyle Foundation Award. Conditions available from the foundation or at the competitions.
  - Open and A Grade events The judge shall nominate the tune/tunes to be played. Three tunes of each time signature to be submitted for all events. Two tunes will be played in the A Grade 2/4 March.
  - Special Events Entry to the Otago Centre Qualifying March, Strathspey & Reel is restricted to A and B Grade pipers who have not previously won the Qualifying March, Strathspey & Reel event. The event comprises one march, one strathspey and one reel. Pipers are to submit two tunes of each time signature and the judge shall nominate any one tune of each time signature to be played.
    - Entry to the Otago Centre Premier March, Strathspey and Reel is restricted to pipers who have previously won the Otago Premier March, Strathspey and Reel Qualifying event or competed in a previous Otago Centre Premier event, or by specific invitation as laid down by the Executive of the Piping and Dancing Assn (Otago Centre). The winner of the Qualifying March, Strathspey & Reel (which will precede the Premier event), will be invited to play in the Premier Event.
    - The Premier Event comprises two marches, two strathspeys and two reels. Pipers are to submit four tunes of each time signature and the Judge shall nominate any two tunes of each time signature to be played.
  - Novice Event For pipers who have not won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize in any event other than Piobaireachd and chanter events.
