- All dancers must be registered for the current year and cards must be produced if requested. New dancers must register with the delegate on the day, before they compete.
- Entry fees <u>must</u> accompany the entry. There will be no refunds if competitors do not compete.
- Numbers worn by competitors must be in clear view of the adjudicator.
- Ordinary events may be run together where possible or 3 at a time and no reports depending on numbers.
- Depending on time there may be no reports given for the Waltz Clog.
- Depending on time there may be no Consolation Highland Fling.
- Dancers compete at their own risk and in the order shown on the programme.
