The competition will proceed with specific guidelines in place to mitigate and minimise the risk of exposure or transmission of Covid-19.

- 1. Do NOT attend if you are unwell.

- 6. Competitors will sit at 1m distance at side of stage while awaiting their turn but can stand to warm up immediately prior to their performance.
- 7. Swords will be placed and handled only by the Stewards of the day. In the event a sword may require adjusting after a previous competitor, then this is to be handled by the steward.
