Rules and Conditions

1. All events conducted under the Piping & Dancing Association of NZ Inc By-Laws.
2. All entries must be accompanied by correct fees. Payment via internet banking preferred. No entry fee refunds after closing date of entries. Entries submitted after closing date will incur a \$15 late fee.
 - a. When a competitor is unable to compete due to serious injury or illness, the Nelson Highland Dancing Organisation Inc. committee will consider providing a refund upon receipt of a doctor's certificate.
3. All competitors must produce current P&D Registration card when uplifting number (photo evidence on phone is adequate). Failure to do so will incur payment of further fee.
4. All competitors dance at own risk and Nelson Highland Dancing Organisation Inc. accepts no responsibility for accidents or mishaps and entries are only accepted on these conditions.
5. Restricted Classes not counted towards age group trophies unless stated.
6. Prizes awarded as follows:
 - Under 14 Classes
 - Normal Classes: Medals 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
 - Merit Award Classes: 1st Sash, Rosettes 2nd and 3rd.
 - Under 16 & Open classes:
 - Normal Classes and Merit Awards: 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$7.00, & 3rd \$5.00.
 - South Island Championship: 1st \$25.00, 2nd \$20.00 & 3rd \$15.00.
 - Sashes/Rosettes also awarded in all Merit and Championship classes.
 - Cards VHC, HC, and C in all classes at discretion of Adjudicator.
 - 4th placing only awarded if entries in class exceed 15.
 - Merit/Championships will only be awarded if 5 or more competitors in class.
7. In the event of a tie, aggregate marks will be used in accordance with Rule 13 P&D Bylaws.
8. All trophies remain the property of Nelson Highland Dancing Organisation Inc and must be returned upon request.
9. Local competitors are those residing in the Nelson Province and who are current financial members of the Nelson Highland Dancing Organisation Inc.
10. If insufficient entries received in Reel classes, substitute dances will be as stated on programme. In the case of reel classes being cancelled due to the Red Traffic Light Level, in accordance with the NZ Piping and Dancing Inc. Covid 19 guidelines, a refund will be provided to competitors if a substitute dance is not listed on the programme.
11. Competitors must be in attendance to draw for all Reels, Merit Awards, and Championships when called upon by board steward or forfeit right to compete.
12. If you elect not to grant the Association/Society the right to use your image, it is your responsibility to remove yourself from situations where photos are likely to be taken, such as at presentation time. The Association does not guarantee that your image will not be published as part of a larger group or performance photograph, and by participating in the competition or event you automatically waive your rights in respect of such images.
13. All participants to abide by current Covid 19 guidelines provided by NZ Piping and Dancing Inc.
