CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entry via official entry form **online at www.cwcchighlanddancing.co.nz** only. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- All fees must accompany entry, and direct credit confirmed, in order to be accepted.
- All competitors compete at their own risk, the PDANZ/CWC Centre accepts no responsibility for accidents, mishaps, theft or loss of personal property.
- DRAWS Reel Draws and South Island Championship Events will be pre-drawn, and the dance order will be as it appears in the Programme.
- All Championship events will revert to a non-championship event if less than 5 dancers compete. Entry and prize money may be reduced accordingly.
- Should there be insufficient entries for a Championship event, late entries will be accepted on the day from other competitors who are already in the competition, at the same fee original competitors already entered in the event have paid.
- In the event of a tie, aggregate marks will be used in accordance with Rule 13.
- Entry to the competition gives the PDANZ the right to record events, publish names, photos and other visual material for promotion as per disclaimer on entry form.
- Recording in the theatre during the competition is permitted but ONLY of your competitor, and if accomplished discreetly.
- As per PDANZ Bylaws there is to be NO prompting when a competitor is on-stage competing.
- For a refund of entry fees to be considered, a medical certificate must be received by the competition secretary by Tuesday 11th October 2022. Fees shall be refunded only at the discretion of the Centre Executive.
- The Executive Committee of the CWC Centre reserve the right to alter the programme of events in any manner deemed necessary.
- Any person found damaging the venue property will be liable for the full restitution, and if they are a competitor, they will forfeit the right to compete.
- All competitors must be registered with the PDANZ for the year ending 30 June 2023.
- Current membership cards must be produced when uplifting competitor's number.
- Piper fees of 80 cents per event (or \$1 for South Island Championships) are included in the entry fee.
- An administration fee of \$20.00 per family will apply in lieu of a door charge, and includes an emailed programme.
- Special Restricted Classes A: For dancers who have NEVER won a Most Points or Runner Up Most Points Prize.
- Special Restricted Classes B: For dancers who haven't won a Most Points or Runner Up Most Points Prize in the last 12 months.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONDUCTING COMPETITIONS UNDER THE COVID-19 Unite against PROTECTION TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM

 GENERAL CONTROLS THAT APPLY AT <u>ALL</u> <u>LEVELS FOR COMPETITIONS</u> Any person who is unwell should not attend the competition. Hygiene: Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. Hand Sanitiser is to be available throughout the venue. (If outdoors competition, ensure Hand Sanitiser is available at the Secretary's Table and beside Dance / Piping / Drumming Platforms.) Ensure washroom facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels. Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided. All doors or windows that can be opened should be opened to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available. 	 <u>ADDITIONAL</u> CONTROLS SPECIFIC TO EACH LEVEL <u>Outdoor Events:</u> - No number limitations. <u>Indoor Events:</u> - Maximum number of attendees is up to 200 (this does not include workers) (NB. Workers include anyone required to operate the business or service, and therefore includes paid and unpaid.) <u>Note:</u> The size of the venue, combined with physical distancing requirements, may mean that less than 200 max. can be in attendance. The Host committee may also decide to further restrict the maximum in attendance, taking into account any other safety requirements. Masks must be worn by all attendees aged 8 yrs (or Year 4) and over unless a valid mask exemption is supplied (Masks only to be removed by competitors prior to performance on stage) Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors. Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day. Im Physical Distancing Requirements to be applied in venue: This includes Ensuring a minimum of 1 metre distance between each family group in changing rooms. I metre spacing should be maintained between competitors lined up waiting to compete and between prize winners during presentations: With the exception of Island and NZ Championship classes, no judges' reports at the Red Traffic Light 		
	 classes, no judges' reports at the Red Traffic Light setting. For Island and NZ Championship events both the Judge and the writer must wear a mask. Kitchen: No food sales should be conducted. Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place – gloves to be worn and tongs used etc.
