Glengarry Highland Piping & Dancing Society Rules

- All events shall be run under the Rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn NZ.
- Championship events do not count towards Most Points (except champs U18).
- Age group most points will be awarded as in trophy list 8-10yrs, 10-12yrs, 12-14yrs, U16 and Open.
- Under 18 Years will be awarded to the most points in the Under 18 Southland Championship.
- In event of a tie for Most Points, Rule 13 will apply, aggregate marks may be used.
- Championship events must have 5 competitors or will become an ordinary event. By entering these events you are obliged to perform in the event.
- All challenge cups must be returned on or before competition day or a \$10 penalty will be charged.
- All trophy winners must be dressed in Highland & National Dancing dress when being presented with trophies on stage.
- Registration cards must be produced upon request & numbers must be worn in clear view of the judge.
- Reports will be given for some events. Events will be run together where possible.
- Competitors enter at their own risk and the Glengarry Society will not be responsible for any loss of property or accidents.
- Dancers must report to the stage manager immediately when called and be ready to dance in order of programme or the right to compete in the events may be withdrawn.
- Dancers must go immediately to the Draws for Reels. All Draws will be advertised in the programme. Proxies will not be accepted. Or following current PDANZ guidelines at the time.
- The committee reserve the right to change the programme on the day if deemed necessary.
- No dancing in the hall and please respect the hall facilities and dressing rooms. **NO** Resin, the stage will be pre treated to ensure that it is not slippery.
- If insufficient entries for Reels dances in brackets will apply.
- By entering these competitions deems you will abide by the rules & conditions as set.
