- 1 All competitors dance at their own risk.
- 2 Competitors must be registered with P & D Assn to dance and produce their card when collecting their number, or a further fee will apply.
- 3 In the event of 15 or more competitors in a class, a 4th place will be given.
- 4 Championship Dances do not count for age group trophies. In the event of insufficient entries (five), the Championship will revert to an ordinary dance and the prizes will be altered accordingly.
- 5 In the event of a tie, aggregate marks will be used – Rule 13.
- 6 Trophies cannot be won out of age group, with the exception of the Open class.
- 7 All cups must NOT be home engraved. Any faulty work will be resilvered and charged to the competitor concerned.
- 8 By entering this competition or event, I agree to hereby grant the Piping and Dancing Association of New Zealand (Association) the right to use my name, image, photograph or video captured performance in connection with the Association. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any person who is unwell should not attend the competition. <p>Hygiene:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. Hand Sanitiser is to be available throughout the venue. (If outdoors competition, ensure Hand Sanitiser is available at the Secretary's Table and beside Dance / Piping / Drumming Platforms.) Ensure washroom facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels. Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided. <p>Ventilation: (at indoor venues)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All doors or windows that can be opened should be opened to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available. 	<p>Outdoor Events: - No number limitations.</p> <p>Indoor Events: - Maximum number of attendees is up to 200 (this does not include workers) (NB. Workers include anyone required to operate the business or service, and therefore includes paid and unpaid.)</p> <p>Note: The size of the venue, combined with physical distancing requirements, may mean that less than 200 max. can be in attendance. The Host committee may also decide to further restrict the maximum in attendance, taking into account any other safety requirements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Masks must be worn by all attendees aged 8 yrs (or Year 4) and over unless a valid mask exemption is supplied. (Masks only to be removed by competitors prior to performance on stage) Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors. Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day. 1m Physical Distancing Requirements to be applied in venue: This includes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensuring a minimum of 1 metre distance between each family group in changing rooms. 1 metre spacing should be maintained between competitors lined up waiting to compete and between prize winners during presentations. Reports for Dancing Competitions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> With the exception of Island and New Championship classes, no judges' reports at the Red Traffic Light setting. For Island and NZ Championship events both the Judge and the writer must wear a mask. Kitchen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No food sales should be conducted. Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place – gloves to be worn and tongs used etc. 	
	<p>Masks are encouraged but not Mandatory. There are no number limits for indoor or outdoor events at orange.</p>	
	<p>No additional Controls There are no number limits for indoor or outdoor events at Green.</p>
