CONDITIONS:

- All events conducted under the Rules of the Piping and Dancing Association of New Zealand (Inc)
- Competitors dance at their own risk.
- The committee reserves the right to make alterations to the order of events. In the event of a tie, P&D Rule 13 will apply and aggregate points will be used.
- Competitors may dance up but points gained out of class do not count unless there are no bona fide competitors. Competitors must dance in all events in age group events to be eligible for points trophy.
- All competitors must be registered with the P & D Assn and registration cards to be shown at the time of entry or another fee will be payable
- No refund on Entry Fees unless medical certificate supplied.
- Most Points are calculated on Method A: five for each first placing, three for each second and one for each third. If the total points of two or more competitors shall be equal, the competitor who has gained the most first placings shall be awarded the most points prize, and if two or more are still equal then the competitor with the most second prizes, and so on.
