CONDITIONS:

Competition to be conducted under the Rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ. Competitors dance at their own risk. The committee reserves the right to make alterations to the order of events. In the event of a tie, P&D Rule 13 will apply and aggregate points will be used. Competitors may dance up but points gained out of class do not count unless there are no bona fide competitors. Competitors must dance in all events in age group to be eligible for points trophy. No refund on Entry Fees.

All competitors must be registered with the P & D Assn and registration cards to be shown at the time of entry or another fee will be payable

Beginner Events: No entry fee, dancers do not need to be P&D registered. For beginner dancers not entered into other programmed events. Dress optional: Kilts, studio uniforms or dance wear recommended.

Flinging – bow to start and end. 32 counts of 2nd point and flinging on alternate feet. No turn. Arms optional.

PDBs and closed spring points – bow to start and end. 6 PDBs and closed spring points repeated twice. 32 counts. Arms optional
