General conditions for Competitors

- 1. Entries** complete with all details, correct fees and levy, to be lodged with the Secretary on or before the closing date. Entries received after this date will be returned. Entries will not be accepted during the Festival, except in the case of an omission in compiling the Official Programme. The Executive reserve the right to refuse any entry, delete or adjust any class. **DEFINITELY NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES** Competitors may not be taught by Adjudicator in the previous two years. Highland dancers governed by P&D Assn. of New Zealand.
- 2. Music** for all dance sections and music accompaniment for Instrumental & Vocal must be on a MP3, memory stick or ipod/ipad these will be accepted at the Festival. Competitors to be responsible for collecting their music after each event, it will not be forwarded by post. **Video Prohibited**
- 3. The** Official Programme will contain the names of all classes and Competitors who will appear in the order shown, except in the cases where two or more halls are being used at once. Due allowances will be made to meet the requirements of competitors so affected. Please note, advertised times are approximate only. Competitors must be conversant with the programme and available to Stage Manager 30 minutes prior to commencement of event.
- 4. All** Challenge cups are awarded on the basis of 5 points for 1st, 3 for 2nd and 1 for 3rd as awarded by the Adjudicators. In the event of an equal placing, each competitor is awarded full points. If competitors tie for a cup, trophy will be shared with exception of Highland Dancing which will be awarded under rule 13 of piping and dancing Assn. New Zealand. Scholarships are awarded on aggregate points. Scholarship money is sent directly to teacher for tuition fees. 3 competitors must compete for scholarship to be awarded.
- 5. All** challenge cups and trophies won at previous Festival must be returned to the Cup Custodian by the stated date in a clean & tidy condition or a \$20.00 fine will be imposed.
- 6. No** competitor, his/her teacher or other interested party shall communicate with the Adjudicators on the subject of the competitor, prior or during the Festival.
- 7. Teachers,** parents and competitors are requested to exercise care in the selection of Own Selection numbers, particularly in the regards to the suitability for junior sections. The Judge shall take into consideration the suitability of the item to the age and sex of the performer.
- 8. Protest.** The decision of the judges shall be final unless a formal written protest is made to the Secretary with a deposit of \$10 as proof of a bona fide within one hour from time of decision, or within such further period as the committee may consider reasonable in the circumstances having regard to the reasons for the delay and the justice of the matter. Should the committee after investigating, deem any protest frivolous or unfounded, they may impound the deposit in whole or part. The decision of the committee shall be final. The committee shall have the right to enforce the rules and conditions upon its own initiative without any protest. These conditions apply to ALL protests concerning the running of these competitions
- 9. Prompting** or assistance of any kind may not be rendered during a performance, except by the adjudicator. Prompting of any kind may result in the disqualification of the competitor by the adjudicator as a result of direct protest or on advice by the Stage Manager.

- 10. Properties.** No heavy property of a nature likely to be of danger to competitors on stage will be permitted, light properties only. Properties to be removed from the hall at the end of the sessions. NO RESIN or SPRAY to be used on shoes.
- 11. Stage.** No person, including any competitor, shall appear on or at the side of the stage until so directed by the Stage Manager or other official acting under his/her direction. Every competitor must leave the stage area at the conclusion of their item. The Stage Manager has the sole control of stage and dressing room area.
- 12. Music** must be clearly defined. Copies of Instrumental, Vocal and Speech items must be presented for Adjudicator **30** minutes prior to class commencing.
- 13. Age** is computed as from the day the Festival is scheduled to commence. Duo/trio and team competitors must ALL be the correct age for the section they are competing in
- 14. All** competitors compete at their own risk and the Society accepts no responsibility for accidents or mishaps, on these conditions only are entries accepted.
- 15. National** Dancing events will be conducted under the rules of the NZ Piping and Dancing Assn (Inc). Waltz Clog to be 6 half steps, Melbourne Clog to be 4 steps. If insufficient entries for Reels, it will become a solo dance. Novice and Clog Dances do not count for cup points. 5 competitors must compete for Championship to be awarded.
- 16. By** entering this competition or event, I agree to hereby grant the Piping and Dancing Association of New Zealand (Association) the right to use by name, image, photograph, picture or video captured performance in connection with the Association. This includes granting the Association all rights to reproduce , edit, exhibit or otherwise exploit my name, image, picture or video captured performance, in whole or in part, in any media publication, Association website or materials, or other Association publication.
- 17. If** you elect not to grant the Association/Society the right to use your image, it is your responsibility to remove yourself from situations where photos are likely to be taken, such as at presentation time. The Association does not guarantee that your image will not be published as part of a larger group or performance photograph, and by participating in the competition or event you automatically waive your rights in respect of such images.
- 18. Novice** competitors must not have won in any competitions, that category i.e. Novice Tap Solo
- 19. Birth** certificates to be produced if called upon.
- 20. Local** competitors are those residing in North Otago.
- 21. Duos**, Trios are to be entered by one partner only. Name of partners must be given.
- 22. Young Performer.** OPAS will pay the nomination fee of \$75.00 only.
- 23. All Young Performer** entrants must enter in at least two other events during the festival.
- 24. Inkbox Entrants** cannot repeat the same pieces/verses in the current festival.
- 25. Videoing**—Due to Privacy videoing will only be permitted under prior approval from the committee which must be obtained prior to the competitions commencing, and must only be of your own child/children

National Young Performer Awards

2021Criteria for Speech & Drama

- A. Performers shall be 15 and under 21 years as at 1st October 2021.
- B. Each competitor shall present a programme of 13 to 15 minutes duration of a contrasting nature marked out of 80
 - 1. One prepared prose of 3 to 4 minutes duration
 - 2. One item of poetry
 - 3. One characterisation
 - 4. Each competitor shall introduce the programme and provide a linking commentary. This should be in extempore style
 - 5. The use of props and/or costume is optional
- C. Each competitor shall give a two-minute improvisation during the preliminary round. The adjudicator shall select the topic. Thirty seconds of preparation time will be allowed. The improvisation shall be marked out of 20 marks.
- D. A penalty of 5 marks will be imposed if the minimum time limit is not met, or the maximum time limit is exceeded by 30 seconds or more.

Society Nomination

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate up to two competitors,

Who shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a performance as outlined in A-D (above)

The adjudicator will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Finals .

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

- A demonstration of adequate preparation.
- An authority of performance.
- A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group.

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any competitor, then NO nomination will be made.

The Nominee is responsible for paying their portion of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. \$175.00 incl GST.

The Nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$75.00 incl. GST.

Direct Nomination

If the adjudicator considers that more than two competitors have reached a sufficient standard the adjudicator may report to the committee that those competitors should be given the option of a DIRECT NOMINATION.

The DIRECT NOMINATION competitor will be responsible for paying the full entry fee i.e. \$250 incl GST

In 1977 PACANZ initiated the **National Young Performer Awards**. This multi-discipline award, represents eight of the art forms

traditionally covered in the competitions movement, and is the pinnacle of achievement for many of our competitors giving them a unique opportunity to perform at national level.

Since the inaugural awards in 1977, more than 100 Awards have been decided at competitions that have hosted hundreds of aspiring performing artists. Through Prize monies and Tuition grants of more than \$300,000 have been invested back into the performing arts movement

National Young Performer Awards

2021 Criteria For Acoustic Instruments

- A. Competitors shall be 15 and under 21 years as at 1st of October 2021.
- B. This award is open to competitors on any (non-electric) acoustic instrument *
- C. The programme should consist of three contrasting pieces from different periods of musical history i.e Baroque, Classical, Romantic, 20th Century or Contemporary.
- D. Each competitor shall perform a programme of 15—20 minutes duration. There will be a percentage mark for the complete programme. A penalty of 5 marks will be imposed if the time limit is preceded or exceeded by 30 seconds or more.

Society Nomination

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate up to two competitors, which shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a performance as outlined in A-D (above). The adjudicator will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Finals .

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

A demonstration of adequate preparation.

An authority of performance.

A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any competitor, then NO nomination will be made.

The nominee is responsible for paying their portion of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. \$175.00 incl GST.

The nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$75.00 incl. GST.

Direct Nomination

If the adjudicator considers that more than two competitors have reached a sufficient standard the adjudicator may report to the committee that those competitors should be given the option of a DIRECT NOMINATION.

The DIRECT NOMINATION competitor will be responsible for paying the full entry fee i.e. \$250 incl GST.

* NB as PACANZ runs a separate pianoforte competition in the following year, pianoforte is not included under Acoustic Instruments

National Young Performer Awards

2021 Criteria for Modern Dance

- A. Competitors shall be 15 and under 21 years as at 1st October 2021.
- B. Each Performer shall compete in two classes during the preliminary round;
 - 1. Modern/Jazz
 - 2. Contemporary
- C. There shall be a maximum time limit of four minutes for each dance, taken from the beginning to the conclusion of the music.
- D. Costumes, choreography & music should be appropriate to the age of the competitors and suitable for a family audience—this will be at the adjudicators discretion.

Society Nomination

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate up to two competitors, which shall be selected by the adjudicator, based on a criteria stated in A, B1 and B2.

The adjudicator will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Finals .

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

A demonstration of adequate preparation.

An authority of performance.

A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any competitor, then NO nomination will be made.

The nominee is responsible for paying their portion of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards i.e. \$175.00 incl GST.

The nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$75.00 incl. GST.

National Young Performer Awards

2021 Criteria for Troupes

- A. Competitors shall be under 25 years as at 1st October 2021. Competitors may only compete in ONE nominated Troupe/Group per studio or educational institution.
- B. Each Troupe will be nominated at a Member Society Competition by performing in any dance genre pertinent to the competition they enter. This competition is for amateur troupes only and is not open to professionals*.
- C. There will be a maximum time limit of five minutes, taken from the beginning to the conclusion of the music. A penalty of 5 marks will be imposed if the time limit is exceeded by 10 seconds or more.
- D. Troupes who gain nomination must be able to attend the National Young Performer Competition which will be held in Palmerston North. Compulsory Registration/Orientation will be on Tuesday 19th or Wednesday 20th October and the competition will be on Wednesday 20th or Thursday 21st October 2021. Timetable will be confirmed asap.
- E. A final will be held on the afternoon/evening of Wednesday 20th OR Thursday 21st October, with up to 18 Troupes recalled to perform. The number of Troupes in the Final may change, at the discretion of the Adjudicator(s).
- F. The winning Troupe will be announced at the completion of Competition and it MAY be possible the Troup to perform at the Soloist Final Award Concert on the evening of Sunday 24th OR Monday 25th October 2021. Due to MEGA NYP and 8 soloist genres competing, it may not be possible for the Troupe to perform in the 2021. Timetable to be confirmed asap.
- G. Costumes, choreography and music should be appropriate to the age of both the competitors and suitable for a family audience.

ADDITIONAL RULES:

- H. Once a Troupe item has received a Nomination, it is no longer eligible to enter another Nomination class. The studio name and the genre of the nominated item will be published on the PACANZ website as soon as PACANZ is notified by the nominating society.
- I. The item receiving a nomination will be substantially the same item when it is performed at the National Young Performer awards on 20th or 21st October 2021. The genre and theme will be the same with minor alterations allowed in music, choreography, dancer number and costuming.
- J. Troupe nominations are subject to challenge and a Troupe risks disqualifying themselves if the above criteria are not adhered to.

NB The CLOSING DATES will be relative to the date of Nomination. Troupe members' names and ages and entry fee will need to be submitted on the Official Entry form by the closing date.

Nominees in the Troupe section are required to include performance copies of their music in MP3 format when submitting their entry, and a list of the titles and composer and/or artists for each piece. The FINAL DATE for submitting music is 6th September 2021.

* A Professional is someone whose primary employment is being paid to perform or work in the performing arts. For the present purposes, being a student constitutes "Primary employment" and therefore is not seen as a Professional. For the student who receives payment for participation, either teaching or performing, this should not impose professional status on a person if it is by way of an occasional bonus or benefit rather than their principal means of earning a livelihood. The exception to this is a participating teacher who may perform.

** As some societies split their dance genres and run large competitions with different judges and/or at different times of the year, they will be able to nominate more than one group to represent their society.

** If a Society had 25 or more Troupes that enter and compete for Troupe Nomination, then they are entitled to offer an additional Nomination. This applies to every multiple of 25 Troupes that enter and compete for a Troupe Nomination. Therefore -

1—24 Troupes = 1 Nomination

25 Troupes = 1 additional Nomination

50 Troupes = 2 additional Nominations

75 Troupes = 3 additional Nominations

National Young Performer Awards 2020 Criteria for Troupes continued

SOCIETY NOMINATION

Each Society which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate ONE Troupe**, who shall be selected by the Adjudicator, based on a performance at the Member Society Competition.

The adjudicator will determine that the Troupe has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Troupe/Group Finals.

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

- A demonstration of adequate preparation

- An Authority of performance

- A performance with a level of expertise commensurate with a National final competition.

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any Troupe then NO nomination will be made.

The nominated Troupe is responsible for paying the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$250.00 incl GST

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicator but will include:

- A demonstration of adequate preparation.
- An authority of performance.
- A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group.

If the adjudicator considers that sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any competitor, then NO nomination will be made.

The nominee is responsible for paying their portion of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$175.00 incl. GST.

The Nominating Society is responsible for paying part of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Awards, which is \$75.00 incl. GST.

Direct Nomination

If the adjudicator considers that more than two competitors have reached a sufficient standard the adjudicator may report to the committee that those competitors should be given the option of a DIRECT NOMINATION.

The DIRECT NOMINATION competitor will be responsible for paying the full entry fee i.e. \$250 incl GST.
