Terms & Conditions

- 1. All events will be run under the rules of the Piping & Dancing Association of New Zealand
- 2. Entries must be accompanied by ALL fees. There will be no refunds if competitors do not compete.
- 3. Competitors must be registered for the current year. Registration cards MUST be produced when uplifting numbers. Dancers may register on the day prior to competing.
- 4. All competitors compete at their own risk and the Centre accepts no responsibility for accidents, mishaps, theft or damage to personal property.
- 5. Novice, Championships, and Merit, Award events in each age group do not count for Most Points.
- 6. In the event of a tie for Most Points, Rule 13 (PDANZ rules) will apply. Aggregate Points may be used.
- 7. Championship Events will not be awarded if there are less than five competitors in the event. The Championship will become an ordinary event with the exception of the South Island which will become non-event.
- 8. Junior Dancers may compete in their own class and one above only, except in the case of Novice class.
- Competitors in Reels must attend in person at the prescribed time to draw for places. PROXIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 10. Competitors must report to the stage steward immediately when their class is called or forfeit their right to compete.
- 11. Any person found damaging the venue will be liable for full restitution.
- 12. All Cups and Trophies must be returned on the day in a good and clean condition.
- 13. 3 entries 1 place, 5 entries 2 places, 7 entries 3 places, 12 entries 4 places, 15 entries 5 places, 20 entries 6 places
- 14. If insufficient entries for Reels dances in brackets will apply
- 15. Numbers must be worn in clear view of the adjudicators
- 16. Events will be run together where possible
