



UPSKILLING CRITERIA FOR P AND D DANCING JUDGES – NEW ZEALAND ACADEMY OF HIGHLAND AND NATIONAL DANCING

Any one of the following criteria met within a 3 year period will satisfy the requirements of “Currency” - Bylaw 29(a) and (b) - also known as “Upskilling”.

- Judges Workshop – accreditation criteria
- Attendance at Dance Development Course
- Area workshops approved by Executive Council (NZAHD)
- Members who are attending regular Academy based dance classes by a current teacher (ratified by teacher and advised to the Academy Secretary)
- Sitting 18 & over assessment
- Attendance as an observer/dancer at an approved summer school for a minimum of 1 day
- Attendance at Technical Training Course weekend
- Private upskilling by an Executive Council (NZAHD) approved mentor
- Workshop attendance organised by any other bona fide organisation with Academy approved tutors eg P & D, Teachers & Judges Clubs, master classes organised by a P & D affiliated society.

In all cases it is the responsibility of the member to advise the Secretary (NZAHD) by which criteria they have upskilled. All of the above criteria except the last example relate to seminars, workshops and other arrangements as organised by the New Zealand Academy of Highland and National Dancing.
